


## AUGUST NEWSLETTER

#### **School Closure:**

### **Typhoon Policy:**

Typical typhoon season in Okinawa is from June to November. Our typhoon policy mirrors the military bases since majority of our students are within or connected to the military community.

- School is cancelled for the day if American military installations are in in typhoon condition IC, IE, IR or SW.
- If IC is declared during school hours, parents will be notified to come and pick up their child/children in school.

- Parents/Guardians must pick up their children from the evacuation site. Do not come to the school (Golden Mind Achievers) during a tsunami alert.

- Familiarize yourself with the location of Kitatama Elementary School.
- Keep your emergency contact details updated with the Admin office.
- Talk to your child about staying calm and following teachers' instructions during emergencies.
