Important Advisory for Parents

School Policy Regarding Pinworms

We want to bring to your attention an important health matter that may affect your child and other students, pinworms. Pinworm infections are common, especially in young children, and while they are generally not serious, they can be uncomfortable and easily spread.

What Are Pinworms? Pinworms are small, thread-like worms that live in the intestines and rectum. They are most commonly found in children and can be spread through contact with contaminated surfaces or by touching hands that have come into contact with pinworm eggs.

Symptoms to Watch For:

- Itching around the anus, especially at night.
- Restlessness or difficulty sleeping.
- Irritability or discomfort.
- In some cases, visible worms in the stool or around the anus.

If your child experiences any of these symptoms, please consult your healthcare provider for guidance and potential treatment.

School Policy:

To prevent the spread of pinworms, the following school policy will be enforced:

- 1. Treatment Required:** If your child is diagnosed with pinworms, they must be treated before returning to school. The treatment is typically a medication prescribed by a doctor and is safe and effective.
- 2. Return to School:** Students may return to school after completing the first dose of the prescribed treatment and after confirming with a healthcare provider that they are no longer contagious. Fill - out the School Attendance Notification Form and submit it in the office. Form can be downloaded on our school website.
- 3. Hygiene Measures:** Please remind your child about the importance of washing hands thoroughly after using the bathroom and before eating. Keeping fingernails trimmed and avoiding scratching the anus can also help reduce the spread.
- 4. Classroom Sanitation:** We will be increasing cleaning and disinfecting procedures in the classroom to ensure a safe environment for all students.

We appreciate your cooperation in keeping our school community healthy.

ILLNESS POLICY

Our parents are vital partners in helping us to maintain a safe and healthy environment for the students in our school. The most important thing you can do to assist us in creating a healthy environment is to keep your child home if they are ill. This reduces the spread of illness and allows your child to fully recuperate. Children may not attend school until they have been symptoms free if they display any of the following:

- Fever of 100 degrees Fahrenheit or more – must be fever free from 24 hours without giving any fever reducing medicine.
- Vomiting, diarrhea or stomach upset
